From Bulgaria to Kenya via USA and across central Europe, the members of the Bridge Quartet have enjoyed introducing audiences to chamber music repertoire especially that of their namesake Frank Bridge and his contemporaries.

Based in West London, they have performed live for BBC radio and continental music stations and in many prestigious concert halls. Their acclaimed recordings continue to receive airings on BBC Radio 3 including the viola Quintets by Bridge and Hubert Parry.
